You [the authorizing fighter] must:

1. Make two (2) copies of this form.
2. Send the original to the Deputy for Cards (Mailing address on Earl Marshal Website). Or, you may submit by email a scanned .pdf of the form to DMCards@Calontir.org.
3. Give one copy to your home Group Knight's Marshal.
4. Keep one copy for your personal records.
5. Go to www.cardmarshal.com and register your information. Once the authorization has been received by the card marshal, your authorization record will be updated and you can print a new fighter card from the website.

Note: If you cannot get online and need a fighter card, include a self-addressed stamped envelope when you mail the form to the card marshal.

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THIS FORM IS ONLY GOOD FOR 90 DAYS FROM THE DAY OF THE AUTHORIZATION.
IF AFTER 90 DAYS THIS FORM HAS NOT BEEN RECEIVED BY THE CARDS MARSHAL THE AUTHORIZATION WILL BE VOID.**

3) Marshal Information: To be filled out by **the Warranted Marshal**.

Authorizations require the presence of the (warranted) MIC and two other Authorized Marshals, or Reserve Marshals (Chivalry). Two of the marshals must be from outside the authorizing fighter's home group. * *Only the Kingdom Earl Marshal or his Deputies may authorize Marshals*
