

# Report of the Calontir Marshal's Quarter Court

## Fourth Quarter, 2005

Introduction:

The Quarter Court met on Saturday, January 21st, at Winter War Maneuvers. The purpose of the Court is to review any incidents or injuries reported during the quarter and offer any recommendations or conduct additional investigations as needed. The Court also serves as an appeal process for sanctions issued by the Earl Marshal.

Summary of the Court:

### Case Reviewed: Dwolm Injury

Incident report received from marshal, Jean Michel Guicard regarding an injury at a Barony of Mag Mor fighter practice on Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> 2005.

Give a summary of the actions that caused the incident:

Dwolm had backed out of an engagement very quickly and in the process had twisted his ankle and knee. I didn't list any opponents since the incident took place after Dwolm left the engagement. It was clearly an accident and a case of misplaced footing. Dwolm was hurt, but able to leave the field on his own. The injury was not severe and Dwolm has recovered fully. No equipment was at fault.

List the actions taken by the marshallate:

No action was taken, it was deemed to be an accident. However, since the injury was severe enough to make Dwolm quit practice for the night, we felt an incident report should be filed.

Recommendation of any further action or recourse the marshallate may opt to take:

The Court felt no further investigation or action was needed.

### Case Reviewed: Callaghan's knee being hurt

Incident report received from marshal, Jean Michel Guicard regarding an injury at a Barony of Mag Mor fighter practice on Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> 2005.

Give a summary of the actions that caused the incident:

Callaghan and JM were practicing with Greatsword. They were locked chest to chest with swords held high locked. JM backed away quickly reversing down to Callaghan's leg, and acknowledges that the blow came in a little low. Callaghan simultaneously stepped back, withdrawing his leg slightly. The result was Callaghan was hit on the knee.

Callaghan was hurt, but able to leave the field on his own. The injury was not severe and Callaghan has recovered fully. An inspection of Callaghan's knee armor found it to be adequate and in good repair.

List the actions taken by the marshallate:

No action was taken, it was deemed to be an accident. However, since Callaghan has had knee surgery and the injury was severe enough to make him quit practice for the night, we felt an incident report should be filed.

Recommendation of any further action or recourse the marshallate may opt to take:

The Court felt no further investigation or action was needed.

Case Reviewed: Thrusting tip entering Ichikawa's Helm

Incident report received from marshal Stanislaus, occurring at the B3R Winter Court event. The Earl Marshal was also present and marshalling at the time and witnessed the incident.

Give a summary of the actions that caused the incident:

During a one on one fight, the trusting tip on a one handed sword slid underneath the front faceplate/bars of Ichikawa's helm, and pressed against his left cheek. However, he was not injured in any way.

Recommendation of any further action or recourse the marshallate may opt to take:

Fighter was instructed to add a cammail or similar mechanism to his helm to prevent re-occurrence.

The Court recommends that the Earl Marshal follow up with the fighter and local marshal to verify that the helm is modified as requested. The KEM will also follow up with the kingdom's marshals in regards to helm inspections.

Case Reviewed: Jack of Banyard's helm coming off during a melee

Incident report received from marshal Stanislaus, occurring at the B3R Winter Court event. The Earl Marshal was also present and marshalling at the time and witnessed the incident.

Give a summary of the actions that caused the incident:

During a melee, Jack was in the processing of trying to duck a shot at the same time he was hit. The helm came off and the fighter called hold as it did so. The marshals immediately stopped the melee.

Recommendation of any further action or recourse the marshallate may opt to take:

Fighter was instructed to replace the chin strap and some of the padding on the helm due to their worn condition.

The Court recommends that the Earl Marshal follow up with the fighter and local marshal to verify that the helm is modified as requested. The KEM will also follow up with the kingdom's marshals in regards to helm inspections.

Case Reviewed: Incident report on Alcyoneus

The Earl Marshal received an incident report from marshal Kagemoto, concerning a local fighter named Alcyoneus, and his actions at a demo held by the Barony of Vatavia on October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2005.

A summary of the incident was given in the 3rd Quarter Court Report. The Earl Marshal has been investigating the incident and gathered statements from those involved.

The Court received copies of the complaint and statements from the witnesses and the parties involved. The Court had intended to interview those involved to obtain more information but due to mundane work obligations, Alcyoneus was unable to attend the event.

The Court intends to convene at a later date when all involved parties may attend. This date has not yet been set.
